Molten Spring Classic – All four of our teams will be competing this weekend, locally, in this 2-day event on April 19th and 20th. **16 Red** will open pool play at 8am in a 3-team pool at the Advantage Sports Center. **15 Red** will begin their pool of four at 2:30pm at VIP. **18 Red** and **17 Red** will be competing in the combined 17/18 division at the ASC. 18 Red's pool of three will begin at 2:30pm and 17 Red's pool of four will also begin at 2:30pm. All four teams will continue into bracket play on Sunday. Good luck!!!

Lone Star Qualifier Results – All four of our teams traveled to Houston this past weekend to compete in this very difficult 3-day national qualifier. **18 Red** had a pretty successful weekend competing in 18 Open. They began pool play on Friday with a great win over region opponent Dallas Premier, and then fell to Epic and Inland in very close 3-game matches. Placing them 3rd in the pool. On Saturday, they won their opening 3-team pool defeating NVVA and Tampa United. In their crossover, they battled TAV Asics but lost a tough fight. Finally, in bracket play on Sunday, 18 Red went undefeated with wins over OVA, Arizona Golden Coast, and Norco placing them 19th overall. **17 Red** struggled on day one losing to Louisiana Elite, Austin Jrs, and, in 3, to Alamo, knocking them out of the race. They returned Saturday with a win over NorCal, but dropped to Skyline to enter a 3-way tie for first and earning second on game count. In their crossover, they defeated Atlanta Boom. For Sunday bracket play, 17 Red opened with a win over Santa Monica VBC, but then fell to the same NorCal team they had faced on Saturday, placing them 26th overall. **16 Red** opened pool play finishing 3rd, defeating Arizona Sky but falling to Arizona Jrs and Willowbrook. In Saturday's pool play, they again finished 3rd defeating Texas Eclipse but dropping matches to NVVA and Golden Bear. In bracket play on Sunday, 16 Red won out defeating Tampa United and Texas Eclipse again to take 19th overall. **15 Red** was eliminated on day one, finishing 4th in their opening pool, dropping matches to Skyline, Braggin Rights, and CAV. They entered a 5-team pool on Saturday where they took 3rd, over Team St. Louis and Six Dogs. Finally on Sunday, 15 Red won their first bracket match vs. Boomers but fell to Brazos Valley to take 26th overall. Qualifier season is coming to an end, but all four teams will be competing in the North Texas Regional to hopefully earn bids to the Junior Olympic Volleyball Championships in Dallas.
